

## **BOARD OF HEALTH**

### **MINUTES**

**March 11, 2015**

This meeting was advertised in the Hunterdon County Democrat, notice posted in the Alexandria Township Municipal Office and the Alexandria Township website ([www.alexandria-nj.us](http://www.alexandria-nj.us)) as required by the Open Public Meetings Act. Meeting was called to order at 7:31 PM.

**ROLL CALL:** Committeeman Swift, Chairman Pfefferle, Mayor Abraham, Township Attorney Sharon Dragan, and Township Engineer Robert O'Brien were present.

#### **ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

##### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Allstate Septic Systems LLP Discount to Alexandria Township Residents- Providing a discount for Septic Services to Township Residents.

Chairman Pfefferle noted that Allstate Septic Systems LLP is offering a discount to Alexandria Township residents as stipulated in their 2015 proposal for pumping and inspection of septic tanks on a group basis. Residents must indicate that they are residents of Alexandria Township and an appointment will be scheduled for a Thursday. The discounted rate is \$215.00 up to and including 1000 gallons. After 1000 gallons the cost is \$ .215 per gallon. If an inspection is needed to determine if the tank needs to be pumped that cost would be \$70.00. Additional costs can be incurred if the manhole cover needs to be dug open. Additional information can be found on the Township website.

##### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Chairman Pfefferle noted that the Hunterdon County Health Department extended the deadline until April 6<sup>th</sup> so that the Hunterdon Humane Shelter can secure new management and a veterinarian. The extension was granted due to a court settlement that was reached on February 26<sup>th</sup>.

### **CORRESPONDENCE / ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

- Free Radon Kits are still available at the municipal office.
- The NJ DEP has charged 8 more people in the DEP crackdown to combat illegal dumping on State Lands. The “Don’t Waste our Open Space” campaign was launched in late March of last year. So far there have been 36 arrests or charges. More information can be found at [www.stopdumping.nj.gov](http://www.stopdumping.nj.gov).
- NJ Division of Fish & Wildlife readying plenty of healthy trout for spring stockings. Some 570,000 rainbow trout will be stocked in waters across New Jersey for spring trout season that begins on April 4<sup>th</sup>. In the coming months only rainbow trout will be stocked due to a disease that has impacted brown and brook trout that reared at the Division’s Pequest Trout Hatchery in Warren County. Only rainbow trout will be stocked in New Jersey waters for the next several years until the future introduction of disease resistant strains of brook and brown trout can be established. NJ Fish and Wildlife has taken aggressive steps to eliminate the disease from the hatchery by disinfecting raceways and deterring birds which are suspected of having transmitted the disease from the wild to the hatchery. The rainbow trout being released in the coming months will average 10.5 inches long. A fishing license and trout stamp are required to fish for trout for anyone between the ages of 16-70. Children under 16 and New Jersey residents 70 years or older can fish for free.
