CORRESPONDENCE / ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Free Radon Kits are still available at the municipal office
- The Hunterdon County Division of Health has sent correspondence to local Boards of Health reminding them that all municipalities must have a licensed animal impoundment facility designated where stray and potentially vicious animals can be safely impounded. Impounded stray animals shall be held at the pound for at least 7 days from the time impounded before the animal is offered for adoption or euthanized, relocated, sterilized regardless of the animal's temperament or medical condition. All animals housed in a shelter or pound shall receive at least prompt basic veterinary care, under the supervision and guidance of the supervising veterinarian, while they are held at the facility. Animal control officers capturing stray animals shall assess them for illness or injury and arrange for prompt medical care for ill and injured animals. Animals that are voluntarily surrendered by their owners to licensed pounds or shelters shall be offered for adoption for at least seven

days prior to euthanasia or shelter/pound management may transfer the animal to an animal rescue organization facility or a foster home prior to offering it for adoption if such a transfer is determined to be in the best interest of the animal.
