

## **BOARD OF HEALTH**

### **MINUTES**

**April 8, 2015**

This meeting was advertised in the Hunterdon County Democrat, and notice posted in the Alexandria Township Municipal Office and the Alexandria Township website ([www.alexandria-nj.us](http://www.alexandria-nj.us)) as required by the Open Public Meetings Act. Meeting called to order at 7:30 PM.

**ROLL CALL:** Committeeman Swift, Chairman Pfefferle, Mayor Abraham, Attorney Dragan, and CFO Rees were present.

#### **ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

##### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Septic System Alteration ATU & Waivers  
B-13, L-6  
86 Rick Road

Kurt Hoffman Engineering, LLC was present for the above property. The Hunterdon County Health Department received an application for a septic alteration design for an existing 2 bedroom dwelling with no expansion with the use of an advanced technology system called Norweco 960 Aerobic treatment unit. Four waivers need to be approved by the Alexandria Township Board of Health as noted in correspondence from the Hunterdon County Health Department dated January 8, 2015. Mayor Abraham made a motion, seconded by Comm. Swift to approve the following four waivers:

- 1.) The toe of the mound will be only 6 feet from the property line which does not meet the County policy of 10 feet. The engineer shall inspect the grading on the property and provide a letter stating the grading has not led to any offsite water problems;
- 2.) The proposed disposal bed will be only 13 feet from the property line which does not meet the Alexandria Township ordinance of a minimum of 20 feet;
- 3.) Alexandria Township requires the size of the disposal area to be based on 1.61 sq/gpd, the proposed design is based upon the requirements of Advanced Treatment which is 1.233 sf/gdp;
- 4.) The proposed disposal bed will be only 67 feet from the Harihokake Creek which does not meet the Alexandria Township ordinance of 100 feet from a water course.

**ROLL CALL:** Comm. Swift, yes; Chairman Pfefferle, yes; Mayor Abraham, yes.
