Minutes

August 12, 2015

This meeting was advertised in the Hunterdon County Democrat, notice posted in the Alexandria Township Municipal Office, and the Alexandria Township website (www.alexandria-nj.us) as required by the Open Public Meetings Act.

Meeting called to order at 7:33 PM.

ROLL CALL: Committeeman Swift, Chairman Pfefferle, Mayor Abraham and Attorney Dragan were present.

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

NEW BUSINESS:

- B-17.01, L-34
568 Frenchtown Road-Septic System Alteration Waiver

Kurt Hoffman Engineering, LLC was present for the above property. The Hunterdon County Health Department received septic alteration plans to correct a malfunctioning system to a 3 bedroom dwelling with no expansion. Three waivers need to be approved by the Alexandria Township Board of Health as noted in correspondence from the Hunterdon County Health Department dated July 29, 2015. Mayor Abraham made a motion, seconded by Comm. Swift to approve the following three waivers:

1. The seepage pit will be only 10 feet from the side property lines which does not meet the minimum 20 foot setback requirement.
2. The proposed seepage pit will be only 40 feet from the neighboring septic system on lot 35 which does not meet the minimum 50 foot setback requirement.
3. Percolation tests shall be used when seepage pits are proposed, engineer performed soil class rating tests. Engineer shall explain the testing selected to the satisfaction of the Board.
