- Spotted Lanternfly Update-Representatives from the USDA office have informed the Township that they are aware of a heavy concentration of Spotted Lanternflies throughout the Township. If egg masses are found on trees individuals are encouraged continue to scrape them off, double bag and throw away. Eggs can also be placed in alcohol, bleach or hand sanitizer to kill them. Residents do not need to continue to call if they find the Spotted Lanternflies on their property or collect

specimens. The USDA is very aware of the sightings in the area and are doing everything they can against the flies at this time.
