

**BOARD OF HEALTH

February 10, 2016**

**CORRESPONDENCE / ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

- Dog License renewals have started for 2016 as of January 1st. Letters were mailed out in December. There is a grace period until March 31, 2016. After which a late fee will be charged and summonses will be issued for unlicensed dogs. The fees remain the same as last year. (\$8.00 for spayed/neutered, \$11.00 for non-spayed/non-neutered).
- Rabies Clinic was re-scheduled for Saturday, January 30, 2016 due to Blizzard Jonas on Saturday, January 24, 2016. Veterinarian Reynolds administered the rabies vaccine. There was 148 rabies vaccines administered (93 dogs and 55 cats).
- Free Radon Kits are available at the Township Municipal Offices.

- The Community Well Test Day is scheduled for Saturday, April 23, 2016 at the Municipal Offices from 9 AM to 12 Noon. The basic kit is \$60.00. Additional testing is available for an additional cost. Additional information can be found at [www.alexandrianj.gov](http://www.alexandrianj.gov).
