October 14, 2015

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

NEW BUSINESS:

- NJPDES Notice of Violation-The Grill at the Pittstown Inn
350 Pittstown Road

The Board received correspondence from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) dated September 25, 2015 regarding a Compliance Evaluation and Assistance Inspection at the Pittstown Inn on August 11, 2015. A Notice of Violation was issued due to the fact that the NJDEP was not notified of a change of ownership and that septic systems that operate year round require visual inspections at least monthly beginning one month following the effective date of a Transfer of Ownership. The NJDEP is requesting that the Pittstown Inn complete a Transfer of Ownership application within 30 days of the Notice of Violation and conduct and document monthly visual inspections of the septic system. The visual inspection conducted on August 11, 2015 indicated there were no problems with the operation of the system.
