

**ALEXANDRIA TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE WORKSHOP MEETING  
MINUTES  
SEPTEMBER 25, 2019**

This meeting was advertised in the Hunterdon County Democrat, and notice posted in the Alexandria Township Municipal Offices and the Alexandria Township Website, (www.alexandrianj.gov) as required by the Open Public Meetings Act.

**WORKSHOP DISCUSSIONS:**

**1.) Solid Waste Bid for DPW Yard**

Four solid waste haulers requested the solid waste bid package. One bid was received by Republic Services. The bid was for two years:

A.) Solid Waste-\$24,840.00

Trucking rate for delivery/pick-up/hauling of roll-off \$215.00

Disposal rate per ton \$95.00

B.) Metal-\$8,640.00

Trucking rate for delivery/pick-up/hauling of roll-off \$ 360.00

Disposal rate per ton \$0.00

Municipal Clerk/Administrator Bobrowski advised the Township Committee that the previous solid waste contract expired last July with Premier Disposal. The contract was continued on a month to month basis up until the bid threshold of \$17,500.00. Since Premier went out of business in May, the Township has been on a month to month basis with Sanico. The Township Committee would like to explore additional options for Solid Waste removal. Township Clerk/Administrator Bobrowski will reach out to a Qualified Purchasing Agent that works in Holland Township to see if the individual is interested in working in Alexandria Township for these services so that the Township's quote and bid thresholds can increase for services. Deputy Clerk Houck is currently taking courses for Qualified Purchasing Agent, but the program takes approximately two years to complete. Currently for Alexandria Township, services that exceed \$17,500 must go out to bid.

**2.) 2004 Ford F-550 XL Super Duty 4 x 4 with Dump Body, Plow, and Spreader  
Truck Auction Results**

An auction was held on September 21<sup>st</sup> at 11:30 AM at the DPW garage. Four individuals were present and participated in the auction. The Township set a reserve of \$10,000.00. The reserve was not met, and no deposit was accepted due to the minimum reserve not being met and not knowing if the Township Committee would accept said bid.

Comm. Pfefferle made a motion, seconded by Mayor Garay to accept the bid in the amount of \$5,700.00.
